Aliya's Resilience in the Face of Loss


Seven-year-old Aliya Firdous lives with her parents and has experienced hardship well beyond her years. Her family was devastated when her older sister—who had been physically challenged since birth—suffered a severe medical crisis. After being placed on ventilation for a month and readmitted to the hospital due to poor living conditions, Aliya's sister sadly passed away despite every effort made to save her.

This loss left Aliya emotionally shaken and mentally distressed. The tragedy cast a long shadow over her childhood, affecting her sense of safety and stability at home.

When Soham's outreach team learned about the family's situation, they stepped in immediately to provide the support Aliya desperately needed. She was welcomed into Soham School, where she now receives free, high-quality education, nutritious meals, and proper healthcare—giving her the comfort and care that had been missing in her life.

Aliya is beginning to flourish again. Surrounded by compassionate teachers and friendly peers, she is slowly healing and rediscovering the joys of learning and play. Her parents, though still grieving their loss, are incredibly thankful to the Soham team for offering Aliya a safe space to grow, learn, and smile once more.
