Growing up in Mallapur in a family struggling with deep poverty, Vamshi's life was filled with uncertainty. His father works as a daily wage labourer, and his mother earns a meagre income as a maid. With limited resources and a household of four to support, the family simply could not afford to send their children to school. As a result, Vamshi Krishna suffered from malnutrition, lack of stimulation, and emotional neglect.



Everything changed when Vamshi was brought to Soham School. Reserved and quiet at first, he had never held a pencil, never recited a rhyme, and never known the joy of a school bell. The transition was overwhelming—but the Soham team welcomed him with open arms.

With consistent counselling, patient support, and the warmth of his teachers, Vamshi began to adjust. Through group activities and daily encouragement, he slowly found his voice. His teachers helped him learn to read and write, and gently guided him toward friendships and self-expression.
