Lasya Sri's early life was defined by hardship. Her family lived on the pavements of Mallapur, struggling to meet even the most basic needs. With no permanent shelter and very little income, her mother did everything she could to care for the children—but her efforts were severely limited, especially with Lasya's father battling a long-standing tobacco addiction.

The strain of poverty took a toll on Lasya. She dropped out of school in Year 3, isolated and unable to connect with her peers.

Malnourished and vulnerable, she eventually developed a health disorder due to lack of food. Under the influence of others in the community, she began to drift further from stability.

Thankfully, Lasya's turning point came when she was referred to Soham for Kids' Child Watch Programme. Recognising the urgency of her condition, the Soham team ensured she received treatment and therapy at a government hospital. After a month of care, Lasya began to recover both physically and emotionally. She regained her strength—and with it, her determination to rebuild her life.

A naturally capable and bright girl, Lasya expressed a renewed desire to return to school. She began with non-formal education to strengthen her reading and writing, and was soon enrolled back into Year 3 at Soham School. With the support of her teachers and peers, she has gone on to take part in school competitions, and eagerly participates in drawing and dance classes.

Today, Lasya is filled with ambition. She dreams of becoming an astronomer—a goal as bold and brilliant as the stars she now reaches for.

Her journey reminds us that with the right support, even the most vulnerable children can reclaim their futures and rise far beyond their circumstances.
