Lokesh, an 11-year-old boy from Greenhills Colony, Mallapur, is not just a student—he is a pioneer. In a family where education was once seen as irrelevant, even disruptive, Lokesh has become the first spark of learning in a home long untouched by schooling.

Both of Lokesh's parents work as daily wage labourers. Coming from a completely anti-intellectual household, education was never considered a priority. For his family, schooling seemed like a luxury that would interfere with work and survival.

Lokesh was initially enrolled at Soham School, but his attendance was irregular and his engagement was minimal. His teachers, however, saw something more—a quiet eagerness, a spark of curiosity. After speaking with his family and better understanding the cultural and financial pressures at home, his class teacher knew it would take more than encouragement. It would take persistence and community support.

Determined not to give up on Lokesh, the teacher involved local community members to speak with his parents. Together, they helped explain how education could change not only Lokesh's future—but the family's entire trajectory.

Today, Lokesh is a regular student at Soham School. He not only attends daily, but also completes his homework and shows a growing love for learning. His hard work and resilience have paid off—he has successfully completed Class 5, and is now proudly studying in Class 6.

Lokesh's story doesn't end there. His success has inspired real change at home. His younger sister has now been enrolled in a local school, and his parents—once hesitant—now believe in the power of education. They acknowledge that if not for Lokesh's insistence, their family might never have known the light of learning.

Lokesh is living proof that when a single child is empowered, an entire family can begin to rise.
