Twelve-year-old Samreen comes from Mallapur, where she once lived with her parents and two younger siblings. Her early life was filled with instability and pain. Her father, an alcoholic and chronically unwell due to liver damage and heart issues, was also physically abusive—Samreen was regularly beaten, and her home environment was deeply unsafe. Without a job and with no means to care for her children, her mother, Mohd Unnisha, was overwhelmed and powerless to protect them.



Everything began to change when Samreen was brought into the care of Soham School, where she now lives and studies. Her mother, supported by the school, was offered a job as a cook on campus and has since become a regular presence in her children's lives. Though her husband does not contribute to the family and still takes her earnings, Soham School has opened a bank account in Mohd Unnisha's name to ensure her salary is secure and paid directly to her.

Samreen's two siblings have also begun moving toward a brighter future—one is studying in college with the support of the school, while the other has started working as a battery mechanic after completing SSC. For the first time in years, the family is experiencing some hope and healing.

At Soham, Samreen is thriving. She is a polite, kind-hearted girl who gets along wonderfully with both her teachers and classmates. She participates actively in class and demonstrates impressive leadership qualities for her age. Bright and determined, she has a special talent for Mathematics and is ahead of the curriculum—her sharp thinking is clear from her consistently excellent problem-solving work.

Samreen dreams of becoming a Mathematics teacher—a path that reflects both her love for learning and her desire to give back. With her intelligence, determination, and the support she now receives, we are confident that Samreen is on a path toward a future filled with possibility, independence, and purpose.
